I got hooked on making little quilts soon after I started quilting and now that's all I want to make! I look forward to sharing my passion and techniques with you during our time together.

4 Patch Block Fabric

- 1/4 Yard of Dark (4-Patch and Border)
- 1/4 Yard of Med or Light (4-Patch and Binding (need skinny quarter)

Inner Border Fabric

- 1/8 Yard

Focus Block Fabric

- 1/4 Yard of novelty fabric - Size of novelty should be less than an inch

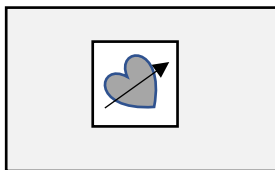
Batting & Backing Fabric

- 12"x 10" piece of fabric
- 12"x 10" piece of batting

Choosing Novelty Fabric

Cut a 1"x 1" square hole out of an index card and place it over the novelty fabric.

You want to see all sides of the novelty item. The blocks are cut on a diagonal so hold the square on the diagonal when viewing novelty print.



- Thread for piecing
- 1/4" Foot for sewing machine
- Small to Med Cutting Mat & Rotary Cutter
- Small 6" square (or less) ruler
- Long ruler for cutting strips
- Stiletto www.quiltinaday.com, Orangewood stick or other pointed object to use to control fabric while stitching
- Bring your Sewing Machine and all other items needed for sewing & quilting (rulers, scissors, needles, pins, seam ripper, iron and mat}



Fabric Selection:

Choose tone on tone or very small-scale prints (1/4" or less). Fabric should have good contrast (light and dark). Medium tones may not work as well. Textured prints can add a lot of interest. Solids also work well with this quilt.
