

Little Crazy Buttons

Supplies Needed:

- (6) different fabrics - 1/8 Yard each
- 1/8 Yard (Sashing)
- 10" x 10" scrap (Cornerstones)
- 1/4 Yard (Border & Binding)
- 14"x 14" piece of fabric (Backing) and Batting
- 4 Novelty Buttons (3/4" to 1" in size)
 - purchased at Fabric and Hobby stores
- Thread for decorative stitching
- 1/2 Yard medium-weight fusible interfacing
- 12" x 10" Light fabric scrap
- "ADD-A-QUARTER" ruler for foundation piecing (optional)
- All other items needed for sewing & quilting (rulers, scissors, needles, pins, seam ripper, etc.).



Please prepare the following before class:

1. Print out the Foundation Blocks:

From your pattern:

- Copy or trace (4) crazy block patterns on to your foundation paper. You can fit 2 on each page.
 - If printing, set your printer to "Print to Size" not "Scale to fit"
 - Cut out each piece just outside the 1/4" seam allowance (dotted line).
2. During class, you will be using your decorative stitches on your machine.
- Please look over your machine manual & familiarize yourself on which foot to use and how to use the different stitches.
 - We will be practicing this in class.
3. If you are new to Foundation Piecing, you can download instructions on my website www.littlequiltcreations.com (under downloads). We will be going over this in class, however it is good to familiarize yourself before then.

Additional Notes:

- An "ADD-A-QUARTER" ruler is nice to have, although you can use a small standard quilting ruler.
- The pattern calls for 1/2 Yard medium-weight fusible interfacing, however if you are using leave-in foundation paper you will omit this.
- Small-scale fabric will work best with this pattern.
