

## Little Funky Farm

### Supply List:

- 1/2 Yard Fabric A for Background and Cornerstones
- 10" x 10" scrap of Fabric B for Trees
- 10" x 10" scrap of Fabric C for Trees
- 10" x 10" scrap of Fabric D for Tree trunks and Doors.
- 1/4 Yard Fabric E for Sashing and Binding
- 10" x 10" scrap of Fabric F for Windows
- 1/8 Yard each of (5) different Fabrics for Barns
- 26" x 26" square of Batting
- 26" x 26" square of Fabric for backing
- 5 sheets of tear-away, dissolvable or leave-in foundation paper
- Pencil
- "ADD-A-QUARTER" ruler
  - You can use your standard quilting ruler, however this one is easier
- All other items needed for sewing & quilting (Machine, thread, rulers, scissors, needles, pins, seam ripper, etc.).



### Please prepare the following before class:

#### 1. **Pre-cut the following:**

##### Fabric A (Tree Background)

- Cut [4] 6-1/2"x 1-1/4"
- Cut [32] 1-1/4"x 1-1/4"
- Cut [4] 1-1/4"x 3"
- Cut [8] 2"x 2-1/4"
- Cut [8] 1-1/2"x 2-1/2"

##### Fabric C (Tree)

- Cut [2] 4" X 4"
- Cut [2] 3" X 3"

##### Fabric D (Tree Trunk)

- Cut [4] 1"x 2-1/2"
- Cut [4] 1"x 2-1/4"

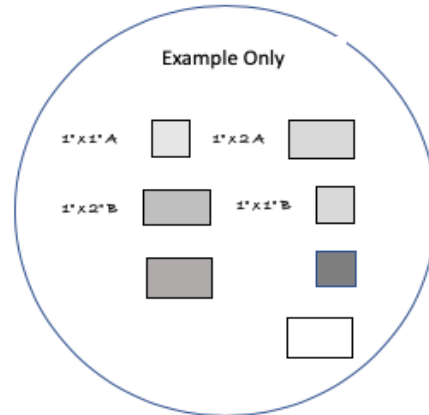
##### Fabric B (Tree)

- Cut [2] 4" X 4"
- Cut [2] 3" X 3"

#### 2. **Print out the Foundation Blocks:**

- Copy or trace one each of the 5 Barn patterns on to tear-away, dissolvable or leave-in foundation paper. **If printing, set your printer to "Print to Size" not "Scale to fit"**
- Cut out each piece just outside the 1/4" seam allowance (dotted line), keep pieces together (large baggies work great)

*Organizational Tip:* After cutting pieces, place on a paper plate and write the size next to pieces. Plates can be stacked up and clipped together for safe travel or storage.
